10:30am	Major business precincts in Western Parkland City Moorebank, Austral, South Creek	Driving tour of major business precincts Drive through Moorebank, the location for Amazon Australia's new fulfilment centre, technology leader ABB, and the Moorebank Intermodal Terminal, an import-export (IMEX) terminal with a capacity to handle up to 1.05 million twenty foot equivalent units a year of international containerised freight. View other significant developments, including Boyuan and Scentre's "Northern Gateway development" (344ha master-planned health, retail and logistics precinct), major mixed living development in Austral, and the area slated as the green spine of Western Parkland City – South Creek.

1:00pm	Sydney International Regatta Centre Castlereagh NSW 2749	Lunch overlooking the Sydney International Regatta Centre See evidence of the \$3.6 billion road upgrade program as we travel to Penrith, one of the established cities in Western Parkland City situated at the foot of the Blue Mountains on the Nepean River.
2:45pm	Western Sydney University Kingswood NSW 2747	Western Sydney University's Technology Business Incubator Visit the Western Sydney University Launch Pad which drives research, collaboration and innovation for startup and high growth technology based businesses in Western Sydney.
